The attention of all the District Educational Officers in the State is invited to the reference read above, wherein Dept. of Education in Science and Mathematics, NCERT, New Delhi has communicated the guidelines of organizing Jawaharlal Nehru National Science and Environment Exhibition for Children (JNNSEEC) 2016-17 in all States, Union Territories etc.

The main theme: **“Science, Technology and Mathematics for Nation Building”**

1. Health
2. Industry
3. Transport and Communication
4. Innovations in renewable resources for sustainable environment
5. Innovations in food production and food security
6. Mathematical solutions in everyday life.

Further, it is mentioned that, a One-day seminar on **“FOOD SECURITY”** to be organised one day before the organization of the District Level Science Exhibition or during the day of exhibition in morning/evening hours as the participants will interact with experts/scientists to generate ideas for the use of Science in our everyday life.

The One Day Seminar is intended to create awareness among teachers, teacher educators, researchers and students about how innovations in technologies and supply chain management can promote Food Security and provide solution to many of the problems confronting the nation and the world.

The guidelines for preparation of Exhibits and Models and Organising the District Level Science and Environment Exhibitions for Children 2016-17 has already been sent to the DEOs and it can also be downloaded from the NCERT website::www.ncert.nic.in

The District Educational Officers are therefore requested to organize the District Level Science Exhibitions on or before 30-11-2016 duly following the guidelines.

1. The DEOs should scrupulously follow the be guidelines given by NCERT (which were already mailed to DEOs & DSOs by this office) in organizing the District Level Science Exhibition.
2. Intimate the schedule of JNNSMEEC 2016-17 – District Level Exhibition to this office before commencing the programme.
3. Call entries duly communicating the themes and Sub-themes to all the schools of all managements in their respective districts at divisional level.
4. There is no limit to the number of students to participate in the divisional level for sub theme wise from each school.
5. Students should be give freedom to choose any one of the sub theme and develop exhibit
6. Judges may be selected according to the themes with special attention and care.
7. A panel of judges may be formed as per the requirement and exhibits / models may be evaluated as per the proforma-VI in the Divisional Level and District Level.
8. The exhibits should be in three categories.
9. Individuals Exhibits
 - i) Group Exhibits
 - ii) Teacher Exhibits

10. Each exhibit / model is to be supplemented with a write up as per the model given proforma-1.

Further, they are requested to utilize budget of Rs. 1.00 lakhs released by the RMSA for organizing the District Level Science Exhibitions on the given themes and settle the accounts with the RMSA duly furnishing the original bills / vouchers to the Director, RMSA, A.P., Amaravati.

Further, they are requested to submit selected list of exhibits @ 1-Individual Exhibit, 1-Group Exhibit and 1-Teacher Exhibit from each sub-theme as per the given guidelines to this office on or before 3rd December, 2016, so as to enable this office to conduct the State Level Science Exhibitions in the 2nd week of December, 2016.

This has got the approval of the Commissioner of School Education, A.P., Amaravati.
